In order to assist the schools and help the parents with kindergarten roundup on April 6th, the Warrick County Health Department will hold a Kindergarten Vaccine clinic at the health department that same day.

-The clinic will be on April 6 from 9:00am to 3:00pm.

-The Warrick County Health Department is located at 107 W. Locust St. Suite 107 on the lower level of the Courthouse in downtown Boonville.

-Typically children going into kindergarten need 5 vaccines; Dtap, IPV (polio), MMR and Varicella (chicken pox) and Hepatitis A if not previously done.

-Parent or Guardian must bring an up-to-date immunization record. If you do not bring the immunization record you will be asked to return when you have that record. **No exceptions made.**

- Children without insurance and those with Hoosier Healthwise/Medicaid will be seen as usual without any charge or billing. If your child is covered by either Medicaid or Hoosier Healthwise you must bring your Medicaid card.

-Children who are covered by private insurance; you must bring the appropriate insurance card or information with accurate numbers etc. **No exceptions made.**

If your child is covered by private insurance, please contact your insurance provider in advance to verify that your insurance covers immunizations (some do not). **Be aware, if your insurance provider does not cover vaccinations you will receive a bill for the vaccines received from a third party billing company and vaccines can be very costly sometimes costing several hundred dollars.**

-We charge a \$5.00 administration fee per individual vaccinated. Cash, check or plastic.
